



JOB SHADOWING DRESS CODE

It is the responsibility of those job shadowing at Community Hospital to present a high standard of professionalism and reduce the infection control risk factor. The following standards have been set to accomplish the above:

1. Appropriate smocks, jackets or scrubs may need to be worn depending upon the department.
2. Hair and cosmetics must be neat, clean, moderate, avoiding extremes. Perfume and cologne can be offensive to patient and should be avoided.
3. Jewelry should be in moderation, no visible body piercing is permitted (other than ears).
4. Shoes and socks – comfortable, neat, clean, quiet. Shoes – no sandals or flip flops, and sock or hosiery must be worn at all times.
5. Clothing – must be neat, clean and allow freedom of movement. Casual slacks, blouses or shirts are preferred. Skirts/dresses should be of modest length. The following are not permitted: jeans, shorts, tight clothing, athletic wear, sweat pants, crop tops, loud T-shirts.
